Step 4



-  I can say the number that is one more or one less than any number up to 100.
-  I can recognise odd and even numbers up to 100.
-  I can use 1p, 2p, 5p, 10 p and 20p coins to make amounts.
-  I can count in 2s forwards and backwards from 0.
-  I can count on in 10s from any given number.






These are a selection of the targets children will be working on in their school work at this level. Please note that these are just a sample and there are a range of other skills we teach the children before we move them to the next stage.



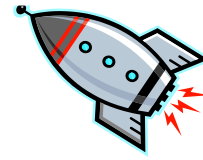
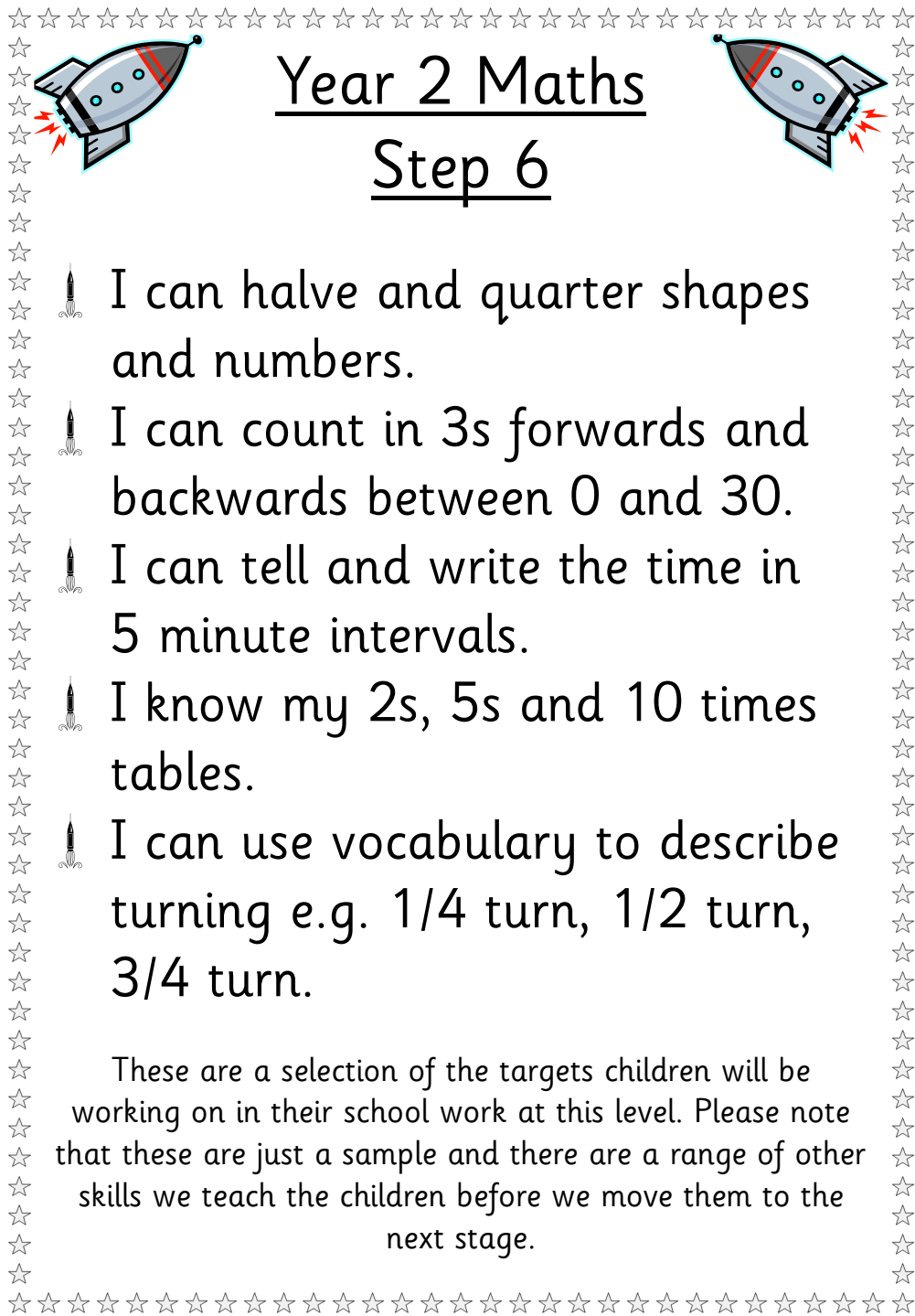

Step 5



-  I can read and write numbers in numerals and words up to at least one hundred.
-  I can select the right coins to pay a given amount.
-  I can count in 5s forwards and backwards from 0 to 100.
-  I can compare and order numbers from 0 to 100.
-  I can recognise quarter past and quarter to on an analogue clock (a clock with hands).

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Year 2 Maths

Step 6



I can halve and quarter shapes and numbers.



I can count in 3s forwards and backwards between 0 and 30.



I can tell and write the time in 5 minute intervals.



I know my 2s, 5s and 10 times tables.



I can use vocabulary to describe turning e.g. $1/4$ turn, $1/2$ turn, $3/4$ turn.

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
