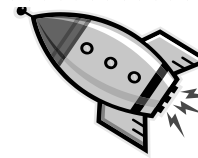
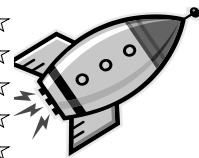
 I only use finger pointing when I reach a difficult part in my book.

These are a selection of the targets children will be working on in their reading at this level. Please note that these are just a sample and there are a range of other skills we teach before we move them to the next stage.




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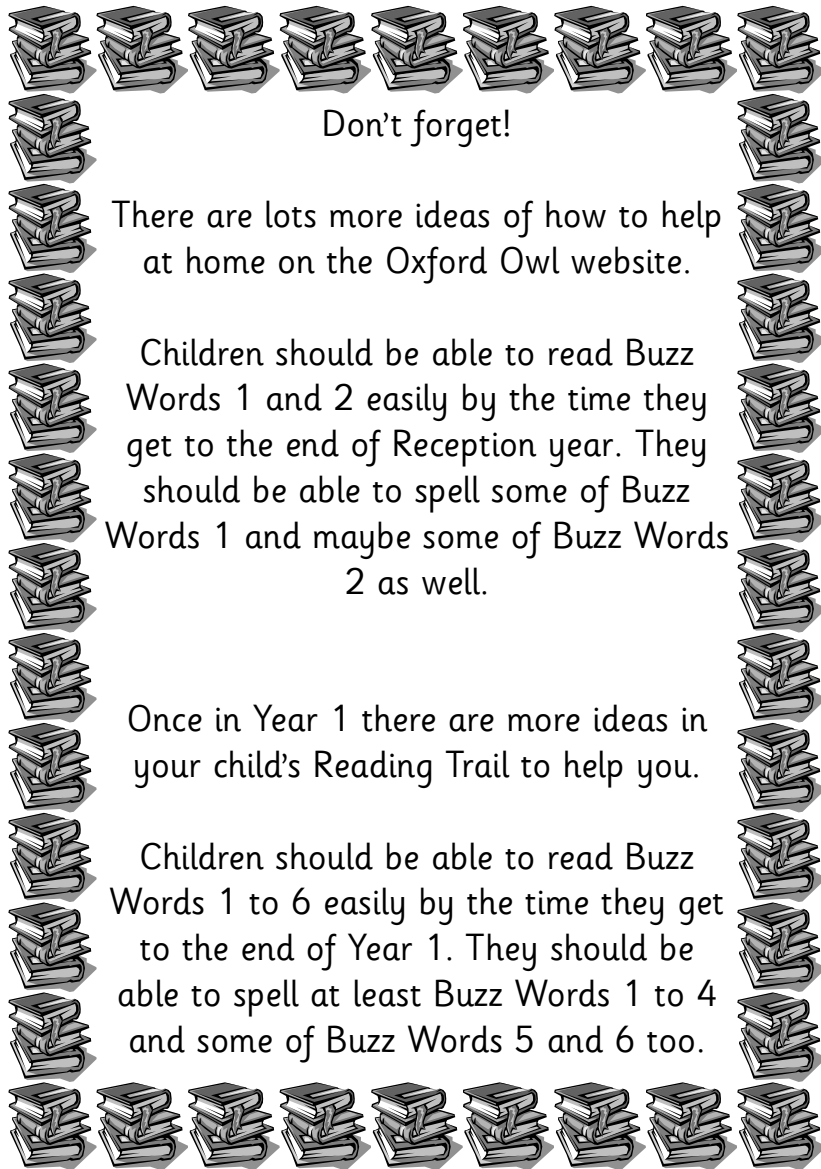
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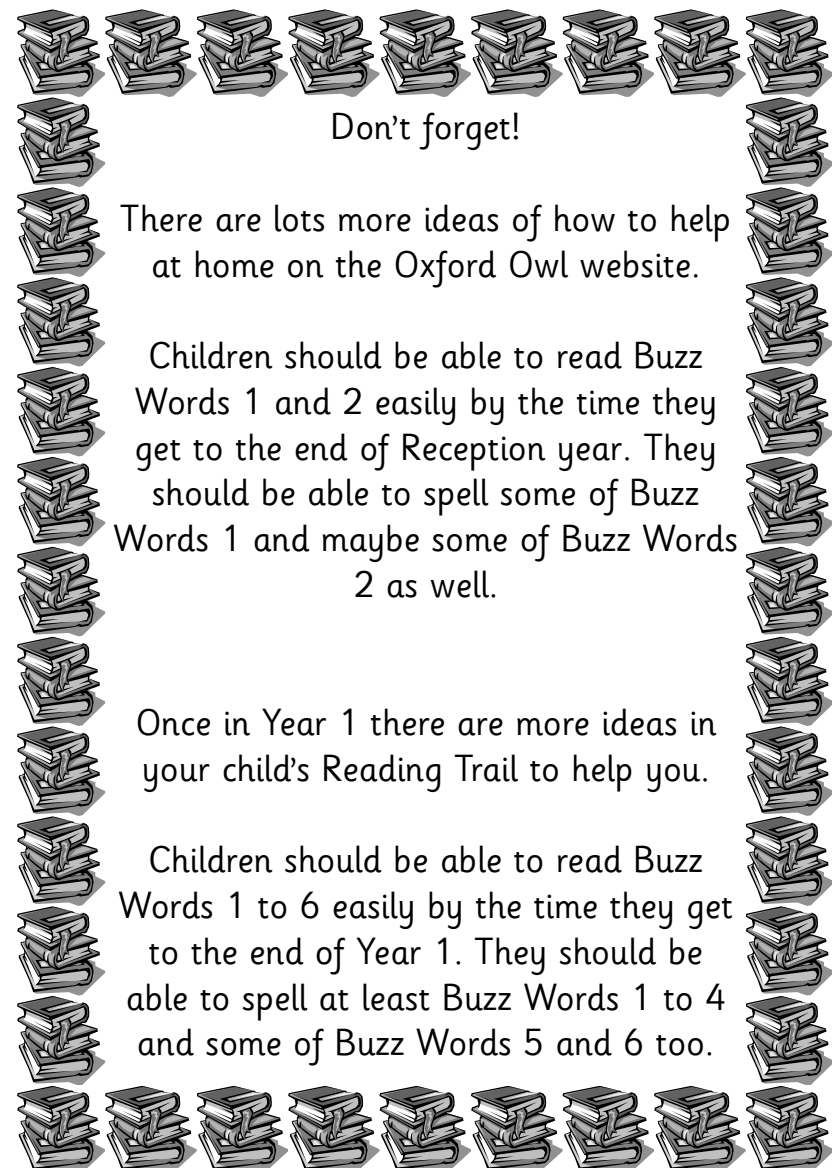
Don't forget!

Children should be able to read Buzz Words 1 and 2 easily by the time they get to the end of Reception year. They should be able to spell some of Buzz Words 1 and maybe some of Buzz Words 2 as well.

Once in Year 1 there are more ideas in your child's Reading Trail to help you.

Children should be able to read Buzz Words 1 to 6 easily by the time they get to the end of Year 1. They should be able to spell at least Buzz Words 1 to 4 and some of Buzz Words 5 and 6 too.



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
