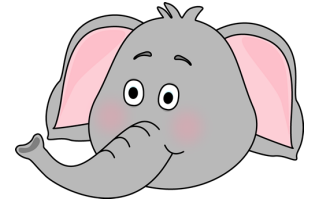


Eric's Learning Pyramid

- ◆ Learning their letters and sounds, spellings, Buzz Words, number bonds and times tables.
- ◆ Learning their letter and number formation.

BOOK TIME
